A great opportunity to train your dog in a Competition environment - in an open space of 15m x 16m. The venue will be set up as a regular licensed Kennel Club Competition. **Each participant will have THREE pre-drawn opportunities during the day to work their dog in the ring for a maximum of four minutes each time.** You will be able to utilise this time in whatever way you wish. Toys and food are allowed in the ring all day. The day is NOT a competition, however, each round will be watched by an experienced HTM judge who will provide feedback on your routine which will be available immediately after leaving the ring if you wish.

FEEDBACK JUDGES:

Would you like to be one of the EXPERIENCED feedback judges? If so please tick the box on the entry form and we will select those we can.

RULES

1. Dogs do not have to be registered with the Kennel Club to participate, however, they must be over **ten months** on the day of the show. Dogs under 18 months on the day of the show must not perform excessive freestyle moves and judges reserve the right to stop a routine if the dog is performing moves inappropriate to its age.
2. No bitch in season is allowed at the venue.
3. Handlers are responsible for ensuring that their dog is healthy and fit to participate.
4. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling in the precincts of the show.
5. No moves or handling which may cause injury to the dog are allowed.
6. All dogs must be under control within in the precincts of the show at all times.
7. Anyone not adhering to these rules will be asked to leave the venue immediately.
8. The entry fee will not be refunded to any handler cancelling after the closing date.
9. In the event that the competition is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances or bad weather, the organisers will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses.

On the day:

1. Each handler will have THREE opportunities to work in the ring. They may work the same dog each time or split their turns between two or more dogs. There will not be any ring stewards so please arrange for a "Buddy" to help you with your props, lead, treats, opening gates, videoing your routine etc. If this is not possible we will try to pair you with someone in similar circumstances

2. Please complete the entry form accurately using BLOCK CAPITALS to assist transferring information. (NB. The order that you fill in the entry form will be the order that your dogs will work). Please complete the form with the **title and performer of the music** that you wish to use for each round. This is to comply with the Music Licence requirements. **Do not put "Unknown".**

3. Music Only one track of a CD will be played each run, therefore if you want a full 4 mins in the ring you must supply an edited track of 4 mins and NOT expect the DJ to replay up to 4 mins of music.

4. There will be a running order on the day and this will be followed. Running Orders will be sent by email prior to the event.

5. Due to handlers using the same music several times throughout the day, there will be no staffed music check in, either "check in" your own music and Feed Back Form to the Music Check In Desk or hand your music along with your completed Feed Back Form to the helper who will be collecting the music on CD and form prior to the beginning of the class.

6. The Feed Back Forms will be sent by email to you with your running orders. **Please do not ask for feedback on "everything" - give the judge a clue what you want.** The judge will not video you, please arrange that with your "Buddy".

7. When you are not working your dog, please try and remain in the venue as an audience for the other participants to simulate a real show atmosphere.

8. Tomlinson's are unable to allow you and your vehicles onsite until 9:00am. The show will open at 9.00am and commence at 9.30am
