Saturday 20th

Class 1. Pre-beginners HW - for dogs and handlers who have never been to a KC show - max time 1.5 mins

Class 2. Graduate HW - dogs who have not competed in KC shows, their handlers may have - max time 2 mins

Class 3. Starting Stars HW - dogs working KC starters - max time 2.5 mins

Class 4. Rising Stars HW - dogs working KC novice - max time 3 mins

Class 5. Shooting Stars HW - dogs working KC int/advanced - max time 3.5 mins

Class 6. Movie and TV themes. Open to all, can be a mix of HW and FS as judged on entertainment and partnership. Max time 3 minutes

Class 7. More than 6 legs - For one handler and more than one dog. can be a mix of HW and FS as judged on entertainment and partnership. Max time 3 minutes.

*HW means the routine must be at least 2/3 heelwork, but may be 1/3 freestyle.
Dogs can compete at a year old*

Sunday 21st

Class 8. Pre-beginners FS - for dogs and handlers who have never been to a KC show - max time 1.5 mins

Class 9. Graduate FS - for dogs who have not competed in KC shows, their handlers may have - max time 2 mins

Class 10. Starting Stars FS - dogs working KC starters - max time 2.5 mins

Class 11. Rising Stars FS - dogs working KC novice - max time 3 mins

Class 12. Shooting Stars FS - dogs working KC int/advanced - max time 3.5 mins

Class 13. Movie and TV themes. Open to all, can be a mix of HW and FS as judged on entertainment and partnership. Max time 3 mins.

Class 14. More than 6 legs - For multiple handlers and dogs. Open to all, can be a mix of HW and FS as judged on entertainment and partnership. Max time 3 mins.

FS means the routine must be at least 2/3 freestyle, but can contain 1/3 heelwork. Dogs must be 18 months or over
